At Tateyama City Myoonin Temple in Chiba Prefecture, you can rent an Ohenro costume (for a fee). Traditional clothing includes a white shirt, a bamboo hat, and a wooden staff.

The white shirt symbolizes the special condition of withdrawal from the everyday world. The staff symbolizes the spirit of Kobo Daishi which accompanies the pilgrim at all times.

Even those who have not experienced the Ohenro are familiar with the sight of pilgrims wearing white, holding canes and sporting woven hats.
